

QUARTERLY REPORT OF April-JUNE 2017

The month of April was a busy month for all. The students had tight schedule in the first week with First Unit Test which commenced on 3rd April till 7th April. On 8th April 2017, the community of BAH inaugurated the Rector's Trophy 2017. It is a tournament to show love and honour to the head of the Institute. Rev. Fr.
