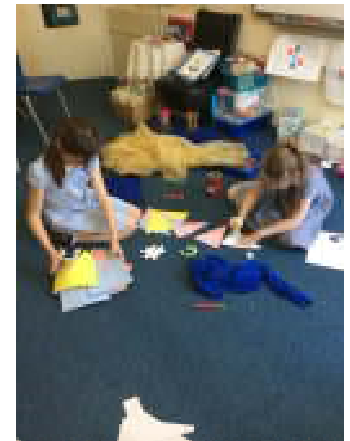

### Staff Car Park
