Reflection on Today's Gospel

As the new liturgical year begins, the First Sunday of Advent reminds us that our lives are caught up in a cosmic drama and that history will end with the return of Christ and the redemption of humanity.

St Luke urges that we live not only by looking back to what Christ has done for us, but also by looking forward to the future. Despite the emphasis throughout his Gospel on the joyful benefits of God made known in Jesus, in this apocalyptic section Luke's Jesus is more concerned about negative behaviour: debauchery, drunkenness, concern for the anxieties of daily life. Jesus here virtually paraphrases the Lord's Prayer in asking for God's protection in the time of trial: "Stay awake, praying at all times for the strength to survive all that is going to happen, and to stand with confidence before the Son of Man."

Advent's stress on the Second Coming of Christ in glory at the end of time, as we prepare to celebrate the First Coming of Jesus in humility and at a certain point in history, remind us that we should shape our faith in terms of hopes as well as memories.

- Lucy's Memorial Service will take place at Our Lady and St John on **Friday 21st December at 4pm.**

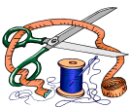
