## Reflection on Today's Gospel By Father Stephen

A younger son asks his father for his share of the inheritance. He then leaves for a distant country, squanders the money, suffers degradation and starvation and ends up feeding pigs. He then decides to return home, but his motivation is quite selfish. He prepares a little speech for his father: "Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I no longer deserve to be called your son, treat me as one of your paid servants."

While he is still a long way off, his waiting father sees him and 'moved with pity' he runs to the boy, clasps him in his arms and kisses him tenderly. The son launches into his speech, but in the embrace of his loving and compassionate father, he doesn't get chance to say, 'Treat me as one of your paid servants.' The father instead says, 'Quick, bring out the best robe, and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. Far from being welcomed as a servant the son is restored to the dignity of family membership. Then the father orders a party to celebrate his son being found again, being restored to life.

There are many ways we can create time and use it more creatively or to help others. We can simplify our lives. Put our mobile phones and devices away for the evening. Turn the television off and spend time reading. Visit an elderly neighbour or someone who may be lonely. Join a charitable organisation -there are plenty of local ones. A short time in prayer and contemplation is never a waste of time. At the same time is there some way we can save a few pence as well?


**Why are we doing this?** Since time is so precious to most of us, it must be a real self-sacrifice to give it up or to share it with others. Yet how much of our time is simply wasted or squandered?
