

#### **Reflection on the Sunday Gospel**

Today we meet a steward or manager of a wealthy person's estate. An audit reveals that he has been squandering the resources of the estate and he is called in to explain himself. Realising that no defence is possible and aware that he may be sent to the mines (dig) or become a street beggar, he devises a cunning plan. By reducing the debts owed to his master, he hopes to curry favour with the debtors, so that they may find a position for him later. He calls them in one by one. One owes the equivalent of a hundred barrels of olive oil, which he immediately reduces to fifty and the other one hundred bushels of wheat, which he reduces to eighty. Shockingly the

parable ends with the simple statement, "The master praised the dishonest steward for his astuteness."

However the manager's plans are not realized but transcended by the surprising action of the rich man. He is rescued by what he receives, not by what he accomplishes. The parable demonstrates a God who does not exact punishment but cancels debts even in the midst of human attempts at manipulation.
