Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

Today the Sadducees confront Jesus. They accept only the authority of the Torah, the Law of God as communicated through Moses and do not believe in the resurrection of the dead. They attempt to catch Jesus out over the meaning of scripture. They quote the law of Levirate marriage, which states that if a man's brother dies, his widow must marry the

surviving brother, and the first born son is to continue the name and line of the deceased brother. They are aware that Jesus in common with the Pharisees believes in the resurrection and offer an absurd interpretation: seven brothers for one bride. Whose wife shall she be at the resurrection? Jesus contrasts their understanding with a true understanding of resurrection and quotes one of the most important texts for all Jews, where God reveals to Moses that he is a God of the living, not of the dead. The true interpretation of scripture depends on having some understanding of the nature of God. Important in this passage is the contrast between the children of this world and the children of the resurrection who are sons and daughters of God. The children of this world are concerned about status, honour and material wealth, while the children of God are merciful, generous and love their enemies.






