Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

As the expectation in the early Church of an imminent second coming of Jesus begins to wane, Luke has a growing sense that discipleship will be played out over a long period of time. He tells Christians to take up their cross every day, while they pray for their bread daily in the 'Our Father.' In today's gospel Jesus shifts the focus to the need for faithful witness and assures the disciples of God's protection in time of persecution. The Holy Spirit will guide the Church during the time of Jesus' absence. Jesus' predictions of the destruction of the temple, war and natural disasters all bringing persecution in their wake seem hauntingly contemporary. They encourage dispirited people by proclaiming that God is in control of history and that punishment of the wicked will be God's doing, not man's. Jesus is summoning us to faith and hope.

Luke's community has already experienced the destruction of the temple, the death of the first apostles and even betrayal by loved ones. Yet Jesus promises them words and wisdom to sustain them and says that their endurance will win them their lives. As Church we are promised words of hope for the future and a wisdom to guide our lives.

Advent Service & 10th Anniversary Celebration of the Meeting Room at Our Lady and St John


Sunday 11th December at 5pm


