Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

The prophet Isaiah expresses his hope for a just king from the house of David. This king will be enfolded by the spirit of the Lord and endowed with wisdom, insight and other virtues necessary to lead God's people. He will show his leadership by judging the wretched with integrity and with equity giving a verdict for the poor of the land.

John the Baptist, another prophet, thunders judgement against the contented and the powerful, pointing to a stronger one who will not preach a baptism leading to repentance but will preach with the Holy Spirit and fire. John's Jesus will be a threatening figure who will winnow the good

from the bad and throw evildoers (the chaff) into the fire. Yet John's expectation was transformed. Jesus was not a fiery reformer but one who ate with tax collectors and sinners and warned against a hurried separation of wheat and chaff. Isaiah's vision and John's prophecy were not fulfilled in the way they expected. They lived in hope and died in faith. We still have a way to go to achieve peace and social justice. But at the end of Advent a young woman, overshadowed by the Holy Spirit gives birth to the heir of David whose message if listened to and lived out in our lives offers hope in this season of joy and sadness.
