Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

John the Baptist is the herald of Jesus' arrival in all four Gospels, but in John's Gospel his role is to offer testimony about Jesus which is completed by his final words in the Gospel: "Yes, I have seen and I am the witness that he is the Chosen One of God." John's Gospel also makes it clear that the Baptist is subordinate to Jesus. He is not the light. The Baptist states "A man is coming

after me who ranks before me, because he existed before me." And although John speaks of Jesus' baptism, he does not actually baptise Jesus. John's farewell is, "He must increase; I must decrease."

John appears as a witness, who offers true testimony about Jesus. Only in John's gospel does he call Jesus the Lamb of God. This title evokes Jesus as the suffering Servant of Isaiah, who like a silent lamb is led to the slaughter. Jesus is the paschal lamb sacrificed for the sin of the world or the lamb that overcomes evil and takes away the world's sin. We are called to witness faithfully to Christ in our trials, to speak the truth on his behalf, but always with the attitude that he must increase and we must decrease.

- Friday 20th January Service led by the Quakers


All the services will be at 11:30 am to 12:30 and hot drinks will be served on arrival.
