

### Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

The paradox of the cross is captured on Palm Sunday when Jesus enters Jerusalem, acclaimed as a king, not astride a horse but humble and riding on a donkey, a symbol of peace not war. By the end of the week a

placard on the gibbet of the cross will proclaim him king in the truest sense, one who rules by self-giving, one who wins by losing. At the beginning of the gospel the angel of the Lord tells Joseph that he is to name the son that his wife Mary will have Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. Jesus praises those who are persecuted in the cause of right. Pilate's wife warns the governor not to have anything to do with this righteous man. Judas is full of remorse when he realises he has betrayed innocent blood. Jesus is the suffering just person who will proclaim justice to all at the cost of his own life. Matthew alone recounts the earthquake at Jesus' death, when tombs open and the bodies of many holy people rise from the dead, a vivid symbol that death is conquered at the very moment of its apparent victory. With Christ on the cross this year are those who have given their lives trying to save others, as well as those whose lives have been simply snatched away.


# Good Friday Walk of Witness
