# **Reflection on the Sunday Gospel**

Expectation of the various "comings" of Christ dominates the Advent readings: Christ's coming in history which culminates the four weeks of preparation; his coming at the end of history, which is highlighted by the readings that conclude the Church's year and provide a transition to the First Sunday of Advent and his continual coming by faith into the hearts of believers. Today's gospel compares Jesus' absence to a journey by the master of the house, who has delegated authority to servants. Each has a different task, with a special commission to the door-keeper to stay awake for the master may return at one of the four watches of the night (evening, midnight, cockcrow or dawn) Advent is about staying awake, watching and waiting. Biblical watching is not staring at Christmas specials or sports events on the television, but vigilance. Biblical waiting is not queuing in traffic or at the bus stop or at the tills in shops but faithful waiting for and attentiveness to God's entry into our lives. Biblical waiting is enduring hope and faithfulness to the tasks with which we have been entrusted in the face of God's absence and a yearning for Christ's presence in our lives.


#### SEAFARERS CHRISTMAS COLLECTION
