# **Reflection on the Sunday Gospel**

"God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life." These words of Jesus conclude a dramatic conversation between Nicodemus and Jesus. Nicodemus comes at night and praises

Jesus, but Jesus says that no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above. Since the Greek term 'anothen' can also mean 'again,' Nicodemus is described -using St John's favourite technique of misunderstanding that leads to deeper insight – as taking this to mean natural birth, to which Jesus replies that he is talking about being born of water and the Spirit. This is most likely a reference to baptism, which Jesus understands as 'from above,' that is from God's completely free act of love. Jesus then compares the lifting up (crucifixion) of the Son of Man to Moses' mounting of the serpent on a pole after the people were bittenby venomous serpents as punishment for their rebellion against Moses. The comparison is not between Jesus and the bronze serpent, but between the saving effect of the lifting up in both cases. The gift of eternal life flows from belief in the Son of Man raised on high.

  - ⇒ dispose of used batteries at local supermarkets or the tip
  - ⇒ take soft plastic e.g. bread wrapping to recycling points at Tesco's, Heswall or Sainsbury's, Upton
  - ⇒ Visit <u>Recycleright.org.uk</u> and learn more about, composting, recycling clothes and textiles as well as what should go into our green, grey and brown bins
