Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

In his appearances the risen Jesus proclaims, "Peace!" in Hebrew "Shalom." He then shows his wounds and the reality of bodily resurrection is affirmed by the meal he shares with his disciples, symbolising that the Church will continue to experience Jesus' presence in its gatherings for the Eucharist. Together with peace,

forgiveness is one of the prime gifts of the risen Christ. The Old Testament expressions for forgiveness image the removal or wiping away of an offence, with the added New Testament overtones of sending away the offence or release from a debt. The Bible stresses both divine and human forgiveness, epitomised in the Lord's prayer: "Forgive us our debts, as we forgive those who are in debt to us." The appearances of the risen Christ bring the disciples a profound experience of being forgiven. All the gospels describe the disciples running away when Jesus is arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane and Peter's denying even to know Jesus. Paul was changed from persecutor to apostle by the grace of the risen Lord. The peace that the risen Jesus brought released the first followers from their shame and failure and transformed them into missionaries and martyrs. Let us recall times when we too have experienced God's surprising, forgiving love.


Printer Cartridge Recycling Reminder


