Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd who knows his sheep and who gives his life for them, in contrast to hired men who neglect the sheep. The translation "good' does not capture the nuance of the Greek which suggests also a model or authentic shepherd. Behind the rich imagery of this gospel are the frequent Old Testament uses of the shepherd image to

describe God's care for the people and that of important leaders like Moses, David and the longed for Messiah. Negatively Jesus' contrast with the hired men evokes God's polemic against false shepherds (leaders) who neglect the sheep and exploit them for their own gain. It is only in John's gospel that the Messiah will give his life for his sheep. Though this anticipates Jesus' passion and death, the Greek expression, literally "put or place my life for the sake of others," implies that Jesus' whole life and teaching is a model for good shepherding. Jesus conquered death. Jesus will lead his sheep to paradise. Jesus is our model of pastoral care defined in terms of knowing and self-emptying service, which also extends to the other sheep who do not belong to this fold.


