Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

The Easter season celebrates the abiding presence of the Risen Christ. St John's image of the vine and its branches is about dwelling on the vine and staying with Jesus. Yet to us that may seem unrealistic. We are do-ers and we like quickly to translate the gospel vision into deeds. St John presents us with a profound challenge – to stop, to remain

with Jesus, to realise God's presence. Often I think of two human comparisons to John's "remain in Jesus," one from life in its fullness and one from early life on the brink of growth. For people in a long, living, loving, fruitful marriage, often merely being in each other's presence is enough; few words are needed, but when one leaves, even for a short time, the other's eyes turn frequently to the door. The two have become one flesh and one heart and spirit. This is St John's 'remaining'. The other comparison concerns the young teenage daughter of friends. She is a young woman of boundless energy and full of life, yet she can hang out with her best friend, spending hours together, often listening to music, sometimes chatting, other times just sitting in companionable silence. Perhaps we should all learn to "hang out" with Jesus.

Fr. Purty has written to tell us that:

"Boniface Apostolic Home [the Boys School that we support] is thriving with 120 students. 9 children wrote 10th standard exams . 7 passed with flying colours while 2 were unsuccessful. The other children are busy with their regular studies. Academic session has just begun."

Attacks on Christians and other minority groups, mainly triggered by the General Election in India, are continuing.

Fr Purty says:

"The first phase of the election is over. This time the Church has played an active role in the political process. We animated the people to choose the right leaders. The Church is going through tremendous pressure from the anti-social elements. Attacks on the Church personnel are rampant and the churches are desecrated at their whims and fancies. In Manipur [an adjoining state] the situation is still burning."
