

Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple is both a joyful mystery and a sorrowful mystery. Mary presents her son Jesus to God, she offers him, and every offering is a renunciation.

So begins the mystery of Mary's suffering which will reach its climax at the foot of her son's cross. The cross is the sword that will pierce her own soul too. Every Jewish firstborn male was the permanent sign and the daily memorial of the liberation from the great slavery in Egypt. The firstborn Hebrew sons in Egypt were ransomed by the blood of the paschal lambs. Jesus, however, the firstborn Hebrew son par excellence, will not be ransomed himself but with his own blood will bring about the new and definitive liberation from the slavery of sin and death not only for his own people but for the whole of mankind.

The gesture of Mary presenting her son is transformed into a liturgical gesture in every Mass. When the bread and wine -fruit of the earth and work of human hands- are given back to us as the Body and Blood of Christ, we too are brought into the peace of the Lord, because we contemplate his salvation and we live in expectation of his coming.
