Reflection on the Sunday Gospel

Today Jesus proclaims his mission in the synagogue in Nazareth, "where he had been brought up." Luke states that his reason for writing is to produce an ordered account based on traditions handed down by "eyewitnesses and ministers of the word."

Luke describes the beginnings of Jesus' ministry differently to the other evangelists who begin with his calling of the first disciples. Jesus teaches "in the

power of the Spirit" and in his first homily roots his ministry in the written word of Isaiah, where the Spirit sends the prophet "to proclaim good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives, and the recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour." This is the jubilee year, which occurred every fiftieth year when people were released from debt and property was returned to its original owners. Jesus' sense of mission is an overture to his teaching and actions throughout the Gospel and to the mission of the early Church in the Acts of the Apostles. Jesus' words remind us too that we as Church must continually renew our concern and compassion for those left out and those oppressed in any way.

In this Jubilee Year of 2025, Bishop Mark has asked that our diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes will be our Jubilee Pilgrimage. Call for Debt Justice in the Jubilee Year

Assisted Suicide

Kim Leadbeater's assisted suicide <u>Bill</u> is now at what is known as Committee Stage, where a group of 23 MPs will scrutinise the Bill in detail.

The House of Commons Public Bill Committee that is considering this Bill has recently initiated a <u>call for written evidence</u>, inviting people with appropriate expertise or personal experience to submit evidence concerning the Bill and its proposals.

It is very important that the many problems with the Bill are brought to the attention of the Committee so MPs understand the major problems with introducing assisted suicide and that they must vote against the Bill when it comes to Third Reading later in the year.
